## COMPANY PHILOSOPHY & PROGRAMMES

We believe that the rich learning experiences our programs offer can affect powerful and positive transformation individuals, in their communities, institutions and countries. ## PROGRAMMING

We tailor each program's content to its respective participant profiles, its thematic concentration, and its country or countries.

## PROGRAM COMPONENTS AND METHODOLOGY

GNBI recognizes that the adult participants who take part in our project's are experts in their fields, and that youth entrepreneurs also bring a great deal of knowledge, innovation and creativity. We see our role as exposing them not only to new knowledge but also to widely different ideas, situations, emerging markets, developed markets and world-renowned entrepreneurs, leaders and advocates of economic empowerment. GNBI sessions stimulate thought and discussion, so that participants may build on their own knowledge and understanding. Conversely, we call on our foreign participants to help inform the South Africans they encounter about their cultures and expertise.

# Volunteerism in Youth and Family

This course is designed to prepare current and future community-based youth and family professionals to better manage volunteers in local program service delivery. Specific foci include volunteerism as a social phenomenon; volunteer resource management; new forms of volunteerism; and future trends in volunteerism.



## Program Development and Evaluation in Youth and Family Settings



This course explores how to develop programs, grants, and program evaluation in community-based family life and youth development settings. Major topics of focus include, 1) planning; 2) design and implementation; and 3) impact evaluation and accountability



# Applied Concepts in Child and Youth Development

This course explores how to develop programs, grants, and This course explores the fundamental concepts of child and youth development through adolescence as applied to programmatic and organizational contexts. A special focus is placed upon the concepts as applied to Community Youth theories & practice.



## Contemporary issues in Youth, Family and Community Science

This course explores contemporary issues facing youth, family, and community professionals in the developing world. Students will explore respective social, cultural, political, and/or organizational underpinnings of issues as focused in two major domains: (1) family law and public policy and (2) professional ethics and practice. Emphasis will be placed on understanding the legal issues, policies, and laws influencing the well-being of families, along with understanding the character and quality of human social conduct. This includes the ability to critically examine ethical questions and issues as they relate to professional practice.



# Applied Concepts in Early Childhood Development
